

When producing concrete for our rainwater management systems, we focus on efficient water and material consumption as well as the use of renewable energies. By using hydration-optimised formulas, only as much water as necessary is used in the production process.

We use high-quality composite for our **RECYFIX channels** from **HAURATON**, which is particularly characterised by its durability and flexible application options. Thanks to its low weight, installation is quick and easy - cutting to size and fitting pieces are also possible without any problems.

Our **RECYFIX systems** have been in use worldwide for almost 30 years and contribute to professional and sustainable surface drainage.

RECYFIX consists of 93 per cent environmentally friendly recycled composite and bears the 'Blue Angel' eco-label.

FASERFIX Drainage Channels made of Fibre-Reinforced Concrete

Our specially developed **FASERFIX concrete** consists of sustainable materials, with sand, gravel, water and cement as the main components. Fibres from natural basalt provide micro-reinforcement, making the channels particularly stable and resistant and giving them increased impact and shock resistance.

FASERFIX drainage channels are manufactured in a resourcesaving manner, are fully recyclable and, depending on the design, can withstand loads up to class F 900.


